



2022 Tax Calendar: What to Expect This Year

With another year in the history books, tax season is right around the corner. We put together a guide to walk you through what to expect, as well as important deadlines to keep an eye on.

We'll be sending organizers and engagement packets from January 10 to January 31 this year, so please let us know if your email or home address has changed.

Individuals

February 1 - March 25: Send us your documents! We'll take all the information and get started, and we will let you know if there's something missing for us to complete your return.

Once we receive all the information we need, it will typically take us about three weeks to complete your return.

April 18: Tax Filing Deadline. If you don't have all your information together by March 25, don't worry! We'll extend your return and give you an estimate of what you owe the IRS so you can make an estimated tax payment.

October 17: Final tax deadline. As long as we get all your information by September 23, we'll be able to complete the preparation of your tax return in time for filing.

Businesses

March 15: Tax filing deadline for S-Corps (1120S) and Partnerships (1065). Please get us your documents by February 25th for us to finish your return on time. We can also extend your return if you don't have everything ready.

April 18: Tax filing deadline for C-Corps (1120).

September 15: Extended tax filing deadline for S-Corps and Partnerships

October 17: Extended tax filing deadline for C-Corps

Trusts & Estates

April 18: Tax filing deadline for trusts and estates.

September 30: Extended tax filing deadline for trusts and estates.
